

Hello, my name is Bob Block, and today I want to talk to you about something that is very dear to my heart—**Machinima!**

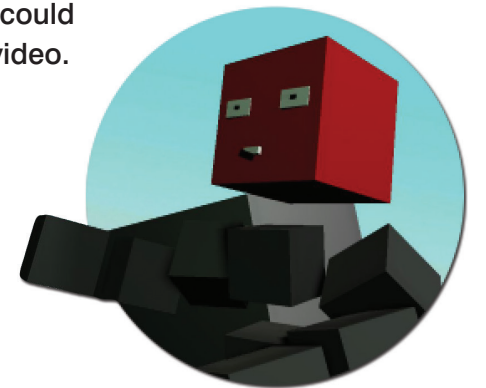

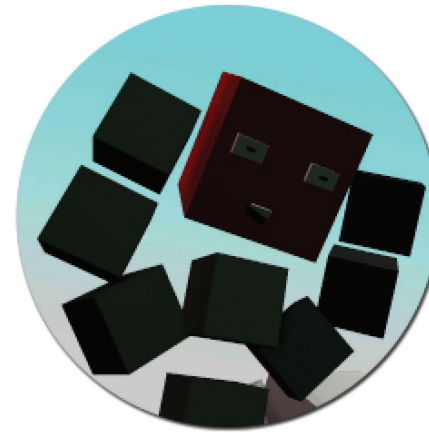

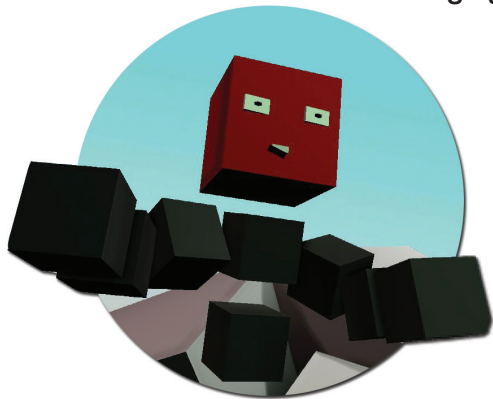
